Automotive Mission Plan

277. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY KOTHA:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is planning to launch Automotive Mission Plan (AMP) 2016-26 with the aim of putting the Indian automobile industry in the forefront globally; and
(b) if so, the details and the salient features thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI G.M. SIDDESHWARA)

(a)& (b): Yes, Madam. Automotive Mission Plan is in the final stage of launch keeping following salient features in mind:

- i. The Indian Automotive industry to be a top job creator – 65 million additional jobs.
- ii The Indian Automotive industry to be the prime mover of Manufacturing sector and “Make in India” Programme .
- iii The Indian Automotive industry to aim at increasing exports of vehicles by 5 times and Components by 7.5 times.
- iv For success of AMP2026, there is a need of coordinated and stable policy regime for the automotive sector.
- v. Specific interventions are envisaged to sustain and improve manufacturing competitiveness and to address challenges of environment and safety.
