

The performance highlights of the Department of Heavy Industry for the month of **February, 2013:-**

I Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd. (BHEL)

(a) Order Booking:

The total order receipts in the current financial year up-to February, 2013 has reached a level of Rs. 15,893 Crs, which include orders worth **Rs. 752 Crs.** booked during February, 2013.

Major orders received during the month include:

Power Sector:

- Renovation & Modernization of Electrostatic Precipitators of NTPC, Vindhyachal - 6 x 210 MW + 2 x 500 MW units and NTPC, Talcher -2 x 500 MW units + 2 x 110 MW units.- a significant order against international competition.
- Renovation & Modernization of C&I system of NTPC, Dadri (4 x 210 MW units)
- Order for mandatory spares for Hinduja National Power Corp. Ltd.(HNPCCL).

(i) Industry Business Sector:

- Bulk order for Insulators (2.01 lac nos. of 120 KN and 2.5 lac nos. of 160 KN) from Power Grid Corporation of India Limited (PGCIL).
- Order for 76 Nos 11 KV DTTs (Dry Type Transformers) from BGR Energy System Ltd, for Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL) Kayega Atomic Power Plant (KAPP) & Rawat Bhata Atomic Power Plant (RAPP).
- Order for 110 nos Traction Motors from Diesel Loco Modernisation Works (DMW), Patiala

(iii) International Operations:

- Order for spares and services from Bhutan, Indonesia, Jordon , Oman & Sri Lanka.
- Performance Guarantee Test (PG-Test) of Unit-1&2 of Western Mountain –II, Libya.

(b) R&D:

BHEL spent around **Rs.140 Crores** on R&D initiatives during February'13 and filed **33 Patents/ Copyrights.**

II NTPC-BHEL Power Projects Private Limited (NBPPPL):

The cumulative turnover of NBPPPL is ` 86.68 Crore up to February, 2013 in the current financial year.

III Automotive Sector:

Meeting of the Cess Committee was held to consider release to money from the Automotive Cess Fund for carrying out R&D activities in automotive sector and it was decided to release ` .20.00 Crore to the research institutes for continuation of ongoing projects and initiating new projects. The first meeting of Core Group on End of Life (ELV) was held for preparing work for the purpose of upgrading the Chennai facility for carrying out scrapping of off-road vehicles in a scientific and environment friendly manner.

IV Performance of major PSEs

A brief tabular statement on the performance of some of the major CPSEs under the Department of Heavy Industry is enclosed at Annex-I. The production of these companies during **January, 2012** was 2.56% higher as compared to the corresponding period last year.
