NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, dated the 12th September, 2017

S.O.....(E) – In partial modification of the Scheme for Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of (Hybrid &) Electric Vehicles in India [FAME-India Scheme] which was notified by the Department of Heavy Industry vide S.O.830 (E) dated 13th March, 2015, the following amendments are made with immediate effect:-

- (1) Annexure-7, Table 7.2: Electrical Range for PHEV and BEV stands deleted.
- (2) Annexure-7, Table A 7.3 : Bus Electric Energy Consumption criteria, is replaced by the following Table:

Table A 7.3: Bus Electric Energy Consumption criteria

Parameter	BEV
Maximum Energy Consumption (kwh/100 Km)	Less than 175

- (3) Under Annexure 13: following New Table 8 is inserted:

Table 8 : Electric Bus


Bus	Category of CMVR	Incentive Level 1	Incentive Level 2
Fully Electric Bus	M2 & M3	60% of purchase cost or Rs. 85 Lakh (whichever is lower) In case localization of minimum 15% is achieved.	60% of purchase cost or Rs. 1 Crore (whichever is lower) In case localization of minimum 35% is achieved.

Notes:

1. Incentive amount will be decided based on the supply order issued by the purchaser. Purchaser has to finalize the supply after following due tendering process.
2. Incentive amount will be disbursed in three equal installments to be paid in three years. First instalment will be released after conclusion of supply order/contract.
3. Incentive shall be disbursed either to a purchaser or to a supplier or manufacturer based on their mutual consent.
4. Localization will be calculated based on Ex-Factory Price.
5. OEM/Supplier to issue self-certification about localization contents; however, DHI retains the right to get the same validated from specialized expert agencies.
6. An additional financial assistance shall be provided towards purchase of charging equipment up to 10% of total eligible demand incentive for purchase of fleet of EV buses as per the contract agreement between purchaser and OEM/manufacturer/Supplier to State Transport Undertakings/Municipal Corporations.

2. Therefore, FAME-India (Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of (Hybrid&) Electric Vehicles in India) scheme notification vide S.O. 830(E) dated 13th March 2015 stands amended accordingly.
