Promotion of Automobile Industry

6304. PROF. SAUGATA ROY:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the growth rate of automobile industry has registered an increase in the country during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to promote the growth of automobile industry in the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI G.M. SIDDESHWARA)

(a): The production of passenger vehicles and commercial vehicles have fallen, however, the production of two & three wheelers has grown in the last three financial years.

(b) & (c): The growth/de-growth registered segment – wise is provided as under:
