NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, dated the 13th April 2018

S.O. No. ____ (E): Whereas, the Department of Heavy Industry notified the scheme namely FAME India [Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of (Hybrid &) Electric Vehicles in India] vide S.O. 830 (E) dated 13th March 2018.

2. And whereas, the Phase-1 of the FAME India Scheme was for two years i.e. FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17, which commenced from 1st April 2015.


3. And whereas, the Phase-1 of the FAME India Scheme was extended for a further period of six months i.e. upto 30th September 2017 or till approval of Phase-II, whichever is earlier, vide S.O. 1055(E) dated 30th March 2017.

4. And whereas, the Phase-1 of the FAME India Scheme was further extended for a period of six month i.e. upto 31st March 2018 or till launching of Phase-II of FAME India Scheme by NITI Aayog, whichever is earlier, vide S.O. No. 3013(E) dated 12th September 2017.

5. Now, therefore, the period of the FAME India Scheme is further extended for a further period of six months i.e. upto 30th September 2018 or till date of launching of Phase-II of FAME-India Scheme, whichever is earlier. The extension is deemed to have taken effect on 1st April 2018.

6 Therefore, FAME India Scheme [Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of (Hybrid &) Electric Vehicles in India] scheme notification issued vide S.O. 830(E) dated 13th March 2015 and subsequent extensions of the scheme notified vide S.O. 1055(E) dated 30th March 2017 & S.O. No. 3013(E) dated 12th September 2017, stands amended accordingly.
